ruta TEÓRICA:

1. PAST SIMPLE-VERB TO BE= Si en el presente el verbo to be tiene tres formas (am, is, are), en el pasado tiene dos: **WAS Y WERE**. **Was** corresponde a la primera persona del singular (I) y a la tercera persona del singular (he, she, it); **Were** se emplea para las demás personas (you, we, they).

3. Los REFLEXIVE PRONOUNS son aquellos pronombres que se utilizan cuando la acción del verbo recae sobre el propio sujeto de la oración. Además también se suelen utilizar cuando se quiere enfatizar que el sujeto ha realizado la acción y no otra persona. MYSELF, YOURSELF, HERSELF, HIMSELF, ITSELF, OURSELVES, YOURSELVES, THEMSELVES. **EXAMPLE:** I prepare breakfast for **myself**, she studies maths by **herself**...

4. THERE WAS-THERE WERE Es la forma pasada de *there is / there are* (Hay en singular y plural) –There was-there were (habían)

Example: **There was** a chair = **Había** una silla / **There were** some chairs = **Habían** unas sillas
