EL PASADO SIMPLE

Como hemos observado el pasado simple en Ingles presenta diferencias entre los VERBOS REGULARES Y LOS VERBOS IRREGULARES. Observa la siguiente tabla y completa los ejercicios a continuación

PAST SIMPLE

Auxiliary: DO

DID

DONE

Regular verbs (-ed)	Irregular verbs (different ways)
BASE FORM TO PLAY TO WALK TO STUDY PAST FORM PLAYED WALKED STUDIED Affirmative: SUBJECT + BASE FORM -ed EX. I / you / he / she / it / we / they <u>played</u> football yesterday	BASE FORM TO MAKE TO RING TO GO PAST FORM MADE RANG WENT Affirmative: SUBJECT + 2nd FORM EX. I / you / he / she / it / we / they <u>went</u> to the cinema

Negative: SUBJECT + DIDN'T + BASE FORM

REGULAR VERBS:	EX. I / you / he / she / it / we / they	<u>didn't</u>	<u>play</u>	football yesterday
IRREGULAR VERBS:	EX. I / you / he / she / it / we / they	<u>didn't</u>	<u>go</u>	to the cinema last night

(Yes / No quest.) Interrogative: DID + SUBJECT + BASE FORM ?

REGULAR VERBS:	EX. <u>Did</u> I / you / he / she / it / we / they	<u>play</u>	football yesterday ?
IRREGULAR VERBS:	EX. <u>Did</u> I / you / he / she / it / we / they	<u>go</u>	to the cinema last night ?

(Wh- quest.) Interrogative: WH- WORD + DID + SUBJECT + BASE FORM ?

REGULAR VERBS:	EX. <u>What</u>	<u>did</u>	I / you / he / she / it / we / they	<u>play</u>	yesterday ?	<u>Football</u>
IRREGULAR VERBS:	EX. <u>Where</u>	<u>did</u>	I / you / he / she / it / we / they	<u>go</u>	last night ?	<u>to the cinema</u>



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Simple Past Tense

Regular verbs

Spelling rules	Examples
base form + ed	walk → walk ed play → play ed
verbs ending in -e + d	like → lik d move → mov d
verbs ending in a consonant + y ↓ change y → i + ed	carry → carr ied study → stud ied
Some verbs ending in a single consonant + the second last letter is a vowel → double the last letter + ed	plan → plan ned stop → stop ped

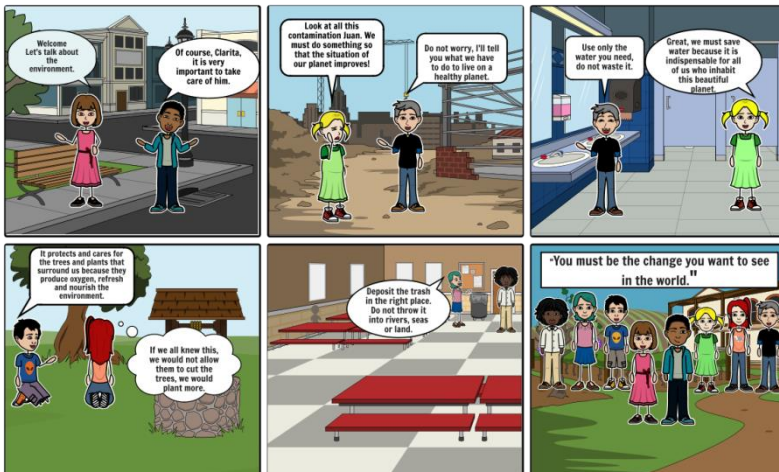
